

New Capital Park Family Health Center opened July 11

The brand new 17,500 sq. ft. Capital Park Family Health Center opened its doors on Monday, July 11, 2011 at 2365 Innis Rd., Columbus. The facility has 17 exam rooms, a community room, and will expand health services for the entire community. It replaces the existing health center located at 2150 Agler Road, and is located less than a mile from the previous Capital Park site. The increased space enables Capital Park Family Health Center to serve 3,000 more patients annually, improve operational efficiency, and enhance the quality of care provided.
